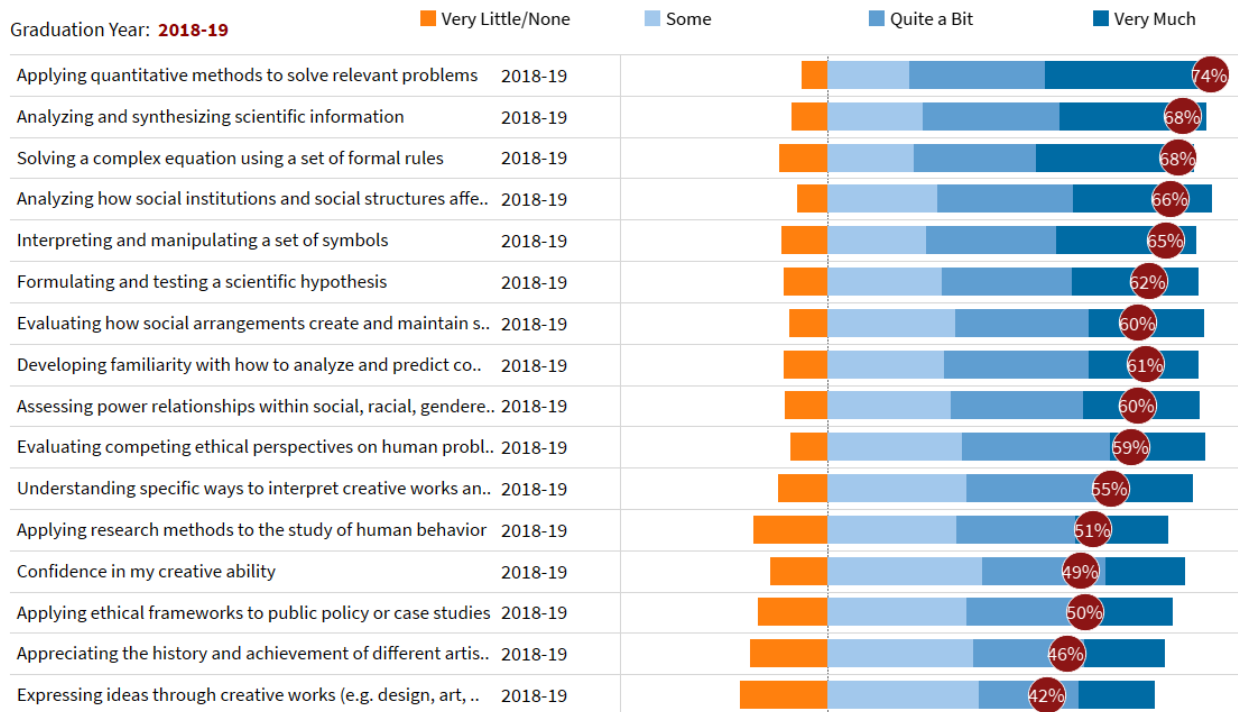


The Senior Survey is a required part of the graduation process. At Stanford, undergraduates can have their degrees conferred at the end of any of the four academic quarters. The Senior Survey is administered annually to all seniors graduating in each of these quarters. For the purposes of this report, an academic year is defined as beginning Summer Quarter and ending Spring Quarter. For this report, data from the Senior Survey have been combined with student data from university records. Approximately 1,650 graduates are surveyed each academic year. On average, more than 95% of graduates included in this report provided a response to at least one survey question.
